Cardiology & Cardiothoracic Surgery

The hospital is renowned for its cardiology and cardiothoracic surgery to our well-respected patients.

The hospital also has a fully integrated electrophysiology laboratory, which includes a three-dimensional mapping system.

Our two catheterisation laboratories, two thoracic theatres and one spinal theatre are equipped with the latest equipment to serve our patients.

Cardiology

Our cardiologists have interests in diverse aspects of cardiology. One of our cardiologists is an electrophysiologist, while others have a special interest in paediatric cardiology.

Cardiothoracic Surgery

Highly skilled cardiothoracic surgeons serve patients with conditions related to the heart and lungs.

Orthopaedic Surgery

Although the orthopaedic needs of patients vary, arthroplasty is one of the most common procedures performed, followed by foot and ankle and shoulder surgery.

Patients can expect experienced surgeons with a special interest in their specific fields.

Spinal Surgery / Neuro Surgery

Spinal surgeons serve our patients with a wide range of services that affect the spine and limbs. Treatment options depend on the patient's condition but can include the latest equipment in minimally invasive spinal surgery.

General Surgery

Our skilled general surgeons partner with other disciplines in a multi-disciplinary approach to ensure the best possible outcome for patients. Patients can expect a wide range of procedures offered by our general surgeons.

The hospital is also accredited to offer bariatric surgery to patients living with obesity.



Internal Medicine

Zuid-Afrikaans Hospital's specialist physicians care for patients who require complex investigations to diagnose and provide evidence-based treatment options.

The hospital's intensivist focuses on caring for our critically ill patients.

Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery

The hospital's plastic surgeon serves patients in a balanced approach to plastic surgery from aesthetic to post-surgical reconstruction.

ENT Surgery

The ear, nose and throat (ENT) surgeons diagnose, evaluate and manage a wide range of diseases of the head and neck, including the ear, nose and throat area.

Our surgeons provide general ENT services to adult and paediatric patients. They also have special interests in skull base surgery as well as ear surgery, hearing improvement and cochlear implants.

Facilities

The facilities at Zuid-Afrikaans Hospital have been designed to support the medical, surgical, preventative and post-surgical needs of patients.

The hospital offers a unique healing and relaxing environment for our respected patients, which includes beautiful gardens and verandas. The hospital offers the following facilities:

Emergency Department

Our Emergency Department is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

The department offers a specialised resuscitation area with four resuscitation bays for adult and paediatric patients, state-of-the-art equipment, five treatment rooms, a well-equipped procedure room, a Travel Clinic and an Intravenous Clinic.

The Emergency Department offers extensive cardiology services supported by resident cardiology and cardiothoracic specialists associated with the hospital.

Intravenous Clinic

The specialised Intravenous (IV) Clinic accommodates patients who require IV treatment for medical conditions as prescribed by doctors and specialists.

Pathology

Three pathology laboratories are based at the hospital.

Biokinetics and Physiotherapy

Biokineticists & Physiotherapists offer preoperative and post-operative and rehabilitative care. They support patients with any cardiac-, pulmonary-, metabolic- and orthopaedic-related conditions.

Training Centre
